The issue of what it means for single men and woman to unite in a soul mate relationship is important. The unity of soulmates helps to defeat the design of so-called "elitists" to divide men and women and contribute to the conquering of nearly all humans.

The globalists, or so-called "elite," have caused wars between nations, between races, and religions. They designed and created a war throughout much of the world between the sexes. Their lies taught in educational systems and the media has brought about conflict between men and women. Their control over families through the courts and bureaucracies in the United States and other countries, has created even more havoc within many relationships.

What are soul mates?

It depends upon who is defining it. From a spritual perspective, it's a mystical, and often fated union between a man and woman. Two people, often enough, know they are meant for each other at their first meeting. Sometimes they are engaged within weeks, and usually stay married for life afterward.

Kahlil Gibran, on the subject of romantic love says:

...when he speaks to you believe in him,
Though his voice may shatter your dreams
as the north wind lays waste the garden.

Still, in the book **SOULMATE SECRETS**, we learn that one can specify, and write, exact traits of the loved one not yet met in the physical realm, and nearly every one listed will be fulfilled in the man or woman of their dreams. Also, some relationships are difficult, but very fulfilling. Others are comparatively easy. It depends upon the beliefs of the partners, as well as their requirements for life lived lessons for spiritual growth.

In one instance, illustrated in *Soulmate Secrets*, a woman declared that she could never consider a man 6 years younger than herself, and her soulmate's signal was a "voice that did "shatter [her] dreams." That man's face was the exact image of one she saw in a dream at age 9, and he came from the same country as the dream: Italy. He fulfilled a long ago dream, and shattered another one.

Much that was taught in *Soulmate Secrets* was known by me long before I read it, both from my extensive study of the subject before the book was written, from my experiences, and from spiritual insight. However, some detail in the book was quite useful.

In seeking one's soulmate, synchronicities should be noted, such as the names of people. In the experience of the author of *Soulmate Secrets* the name "Beth" came up in a dream before she met her husband. That was

short for "Elizabeth." In the author of **Eat Pray Love**, Elizabeth Gilbert's experience, she met a man who nearly ran both she, and her bicycle, off the road. Now, that is truly "running into someone" as the expression goes. He had been placing a music tape in the car when this happened. Then they met again later, the song started playing just then in a public place.

I know in my own experience, names come up in dreams, and I meet the person soon after. I know this was not my imagination, because I used to keep a dream diary. This does not always signify a soulmate, but it can be a significant business connection, or some important friendship.

The names in one's dreams are important, but when one name comes up repeatedly over a period of years, and then you meet a person who is unusually attractive to you, and the unity of mind and heart is unusual, the encounter is probably very meaningful and that is probably the name of your soulmate. The same is true of an image of a face in a dream that is exactly correct in your awake experience.

The most important information I can convey here is that we all have different paths. However, the most important mission of a soulmate relationship is that both grow in spiritual awareness through that union, and that many more others are brought to spiritual awareness than if both had remained single.

FEAR VS LOVE:

What do you think *Eat, Pray, Love*, by Elizabeth Gilbert, is, at its core, about?

It is about the age old problem of fear vs love. What do you think the issue of world peace, freedom, and prosperity is about? It's about fear vs love. The story did not convey a message of world peace, but the lesson of fear vs love is the same. It is also about finding one's self, which is very important in our quest for world peace.

What is it to find one's self?

[Joe Marshalla](#) says that if you believe you are your thoughts, you are under mind control.

It is essential to find one's true self to be able to meditate upon world peace in such a way that you help to bring about that state of peace worldwide. That is because if you are not at peace within, you cannot help bring peace to this world, except in the most superficial ways.

What is the self?

The self is not your thoughts, your emotions, your desires, or your body. The self has no beginning, and no end. It existed before your body came into being, and it will be there after your body dies. You can best experience that self if you visualize, and sense, it as having always been, and that it always will be.

The reason you can quiet the mind during meditation is because you have found your core self that is not thought, not emotion, not desire, and not a body. You have no desire to quiet

your thoughts. You are, at your core, something far greater than desire.

That does not mean that fulfilled desire, thoughts, or your body are not good, wholesome, and wonderful. It just means they have a certain place in your life, and with the divine increasingly awakened within you, you will manifest your desires, emotions, healthy body, and thoughts in the most harmonious ways.
